3 Ways to Delete Videos from Android.

Whatever is your reason for wanting to delete videos from Android, there are various ways you can go about it.

Erase Android.

An Android (Samsung Galaxy Note7) smartphone or tablet is a great asset for storing your videos, images, documents and many other files in addition to enjoying your mobile games, social media, and the internet. However, you may want to free some of your phone's or SD card's memory when it starts running low by deleting some videos. You may also want to delete an accidentally downloaded video or one that you feel is inappropriate. Whatever your reason for wanting to delete videos from Android, there are various ways you can go about it.

Method 1. Delete the Videos from Gallery on Android.

Guides on how to Delete Videos from Gallery:

Step 1. From your Android device main menu, scroll and tap on the gallery application to launch. It should give you several folders containing both photos and videos.

Step 2. Go to the "Videos" folder and tap to open it. It should display all the videos located on both your SD card and internal memory.

Step 3. Now scroll to locate the video you want to delete, long tap on it and tick the checkbox on your right to select it for deleting. As you will notice, you can batch-select several videos for deletion by ticking on their respective checkboxes on the right.

Step 4. Locate the trash bin icon after selecting your videos and tap on it to delete. Tap ok once a prompt asking whether to "delete these files", or "these files will be deleted" to confirm the deletion.

Method 2: Delete Videos in Android "My Files" Setting.

You can also delete videos from Android using the "My Files" setting. Follow the steps below.

Guides on how to delete videos from Android:

Step 1. Open your Android (for example: Samsung Galaxy Note7) phone's main menu and tap on "My Files".

Step 2. Now go to the video containing folder and tap to open. This could be the DCIM or Videos folder or another folder such as the Bluetooth folder depending on your device and Android OS.

Step 3. Highlight the video to be deleted by long tapping to select it for deletion.

Alternatively: Depending on the specific Android device and OS, you can also open the file manager, and tap on the "Videos" folder. This will display all the videos on your phone's internal and SD card memories. Select the video you want to delete by long tapping and ticking on the checkbox to the right. Tap delete or trash bin icon and confirm delete by tapping "ok" on the pop-up prompt.

Method 3: Delete Videos in SD Card on Android.

Any of the above methods can delete a video saved in Android SD card. However, the following steps can be more effective.

Guides on how to delete videos on Android:

Step 1. Open you main menu and go to settings.

Step 2. Tap on "Storage" followed by "Pictures and Videos under SD card storage". This should open your default gallery app.

Step 3. Follow the steps to delete videos from gallery. Alternatively, you can go to "Format SD card" under storage settings, but this will delete all the contents of the SD card so you better have a backup.

Alternative: You can also delete the unwanted video files from your Android device through USB connection to you windows or Mac PC. Just locate the device from my computer and explore both SD (removable storage device) and mobile device folders to locate the video you want to delete. Select the video using you mouse cursor, right click for a drop down menu and click on "delete".p>

Step 3. From the menu, choose "wipe cache partition" option using the volume down and power key.

Recommendation: The Simplest Way to Delete All Data on Android.

How to remove all data on Android with dr.fone.

Step 1 Download and Launch.

Please start with downloading and launching the dr.fone on your computer and select the "Erase" section from the application menu below.

Step 2 Begin to wipe your android phone/tablet device permanently.

Hit the "Start" button as shown below to begin erasing all the data on your android phones or tablets irrevocably.

Step 3 Perform factory reset on Android.

In the end, to erase all settings on your android phone or tablet, you need to tap "Factory data reset" on android device when a pop-up message is sent to you.

Delete or disable apps on Android.

You can uninstall apps you've installed on your phone. If you remove an app you paid for, you can reinstall it later without buying it again. You can also disable system apps that came with your phone.

Delete apps that you installed.

Open the Google Play Store app. At the top right, tap the profile icon. Tap Manage apps & devices Installed. Next to the app, tap Uninstall.

Disable apps that came with your phone.

You can't delete some system apps that came pre-installed on your Android phone. But on some phones, you can turn them off so that they won't show on the list of apps on your phone. To learn how to disable apps, contact your device manufacturer.

What to Know.

Open the Files app and select the Downloads category. Tap and hold the files you want to delete to select them. Tap the Trash icon. Android asks if you're sure you want to delete the selected files. Confirm that you do. Note: You can also use the Files app to delete unwanted images, videos, audio, and more.

This article explains how to get rid of unwanted downloads on an Android device. It's not hard, but locating the files can be tricky if you don't know where to look.

How to Open and Edit Files.

Every Android device has a specific app to manage your downloaded or saved files, but it may take a bit of searching to find, depending on your device. Here's how you browse through the different files you have.

When you delete files on your Android device, they are gone permanently, so be sure you really do want to delete them completely before following these instructions.

The app you are looking for is going to be called either Files or My Files, depending on the age of your device. To find the Files app, open the App Tray on your device. You may have to search a little. Look in a Tools folder if you don't see it directly on the App Tray.

Inside the Files app, you can browse several different categories: images, videos, music, etc.

From here, you can tap files to access them or tap and hold to select multiple files at once. Depending on the type of file, there are different actions

you can take once you have multiple files selected.

Pay a special note to the Documents section. If you've downloaded PDFs — tickets to an event, a restaurant menu, etc. — from a browser on your mobile device, they often just sit on your phone, taking up space.

Downloads from your web browser are stored in your downloads file, so when you delete them directly from the file, there's no need to delete them from your browser. If you want to double check that, however, you can always open your web browser and go to Settings (usually represented by a three dot or three line menu icon) > Downloads to ensure all the files you want to delete are gone.

Once you've selected the files you want to delete, tap Delete , which is usually represented by a trash can icon.

You may be prompted to confirm you want to delete the files. Tap Delete or Yes , depending on your operating system, to permanently delete the files.

How to Delete Files on Your Android Device.

Once you've found the Files app, deleting your files is a snap. Here's how you do it.

Tap and hold your finger on the file you want to delete, then select either the Delete option or the Trash icon that appears.

You can select multiple files to delete several at once. Each one should receive a check mark if you tap and hold down on it - check several of them before selecting delete to take care of many files at once.

After you select to delete files, you will be prompted if you really want to delete those files. They are gone for good once you select OK , so make sure you've chosen wisely.

Downloaded files can take up lots of space on your Android. If you've never installed an additional SD card or added space to your phone, that can be a valuable commodity! It's a good idea to clear out space every so often so you can download more of your favorite apps, music, and videos.

User Guide: How to Delete Music from Android Phone/Tablet Effectively?

You have an Android phone or tablet which you have filled with all sorts of song among other audio files? Then after a certain time, you will need to delete music from your Android phone or Tablet since they take up too much space on your device and slow down the device. But during the deleting process, there are problems would arise to obstruct you. And one of the common problems is- it is hard to delete songs permanently from a device.

If you have encountered with those problems above and wish to solve them effortlessly, it's time to have a try with the some powerful third-party software. Here we have four different suggestions for you:

Option 1. Delete Music from Android Using An Android Assistant Program

Here, MobiKin Assistant for Android would be a good helper for you. It is a software that can help you to transfer, export, import, delete, backup and manages the applications, contacts, text messages, photos, videos, music and other files in an Android phone or tablet and deals with it in one place on your personal computer. It works with overall Android devices, including Samsung, HTC, Motorola, LG, Sony, Huawei, ZTE, Lenovo, etc. So with the help of this program, you are able to free up your Android phone by exporting songs or deleting unwanted music. Both of operations can be easily completed in this software.

Now let's see how this tool works:

Step 1. Connect your Android device to your computer.

Start your Android music manager - Assistant for Android on your computer and link it on your Android tablet or phone using a data cable. The Android program will recognize your device and display it on the main window showing all the data in the left panel.

Step 2. Delete/Export music from Android.

After establishing connection between your phone and the program, you can start to delete or export the songs now. Just click on Music option

from the left to show all the audio files on your device on the right side window. Preview and select the music files you want to remove or export from your Android device and then you can:

- Delete the files: tap on the "Delete" button from the top menu bar to remove the selected songs.
- Export the data: click on the "Export" button from the menu to sync the selected files to computer and then delete them on your phone.

You may also want to know:

Option 2. Delete All Music Files from Android Quickly on PC.

You can easily delete music files from your Android device using your PC. If you want to discard all the music files in the SD card on your Android phone, this option is perfect for you. Below, we give instructions on how to use the PC system to delete music files from Android phone:

Step 1 : Unlock and open your Android device, select the "Menu" icon, then find and open the "Settings" option.

Step 2 : From the "Settings" option, select the "SD card and phone storage" option and click "Unmount SD card".

Step 3 : Now you can slide the back cover and safely remove the SD card from your Android device. Then insert the SD card into an SD card reader and connect it to the computer. Once detected by the computer, you can double-click the icon of the SD card/removable disk displayed in the lower right corner of the PC window.

Step 4 : Once opened, you can browse all the folders stored on the SD card until you find the folder where the music files are stored. In general, the folder is named "Music".

Step 5 : Open the Music folder, select all the music files you want to delete and move them to the trash. If you want to permanently delete them without recovery, you can choose to empty the recycle bin, then these music files will disappear permanently.

Option 3. Delete Songs on Android using Google Play Music App.

We know that every Android phone is now basically equipped with the Google Play Music App. With this app, you can easily find all the songs stored on your device. In this section, we'll show you how to use the Google Play Music app to delete all songs on your Android phone.

Step 1 . First open your Android device and launch the Google Play Music app.

Step 2 . Click on the "Music Library" option in the upper left corner of the application interface screen to view the application's menu panel. Select "My Library" and your music list will be displayed.

Step 3 . Now select the track you want to delete and click on the menu icon on the side of the selected track.

Step 4 . Finally, click on "Delete" from the context menu.

That's it! Your song will be removed from your Android device. Now, you can repeat the above steps to delete other tracks. Of course, you can also select the tracks in one thread and delete them altogether by tapping the "Trash" icon.

Note : What you need to know is that by deleting the music files in your Android phone by the above method, any expert hacker can use some file recovery tools to retrieve the deleted Android music files. If you want to permanently delete music files from your Android phone, you need a third-party Android data erasing tool. This will be covered in detail in the fourth part.

Option 4. Permanently Remove All Android Music with Android Cleaner Software.

Some users may want to use a cleaning software to directly remove the unwanted songs so here, we would like to suggest you to use the Android Data Eraser . As its name suggests, this is a professional software to clean the Android phones like Samsung, Huawei, LG, HTC, Motorola, etc. The highlight of this software is that it can permanently wipe the data on your Android phone. In other words, all the files that are erased by this tool won't be restorable.

At present, this software only supports to erase all data for Android devices. So please backup your Android files before deleting the data or you will lose all the files permanently.

Tutorial to completely clean Android files:

Step 1. Download and install the software.

First of all, you need to download the software by clicking the icon below and then go with the instructions to properly install it.

Step 2. Connect your Android phone to PC.

Connect your Android phone to computer and then launch the installed tool. During the connecting process, you need to go with the prompts on the screen to make the phone recognized, such as enabling USB debugging. Once the Android phone is recognized by the software, you will see an interface as below:

Step 3. Select security level.

When the software detects your Android device successfully, you can click "Erase" button on the main interface and then tap on "Medium" to choose a security level according to your need.

Step 4. Remove the Android files.

Finally, just type "delete" in the "Erase All Data" interface and click the "Erase" button located at the bottom right corner. Then all the files on Android, including the songs, will be removed from your Android phone immediately.

Conclusion.

All the options above are helpful to clean the Android music but I think the assistant software would be better here cause it won't affect other files on your phone and you can also manage other data like photos, videos, messages, etc. with it. Anyway, just choose the one you like to delete music from your Android phone or Tablet so you can better enjoy the device.
